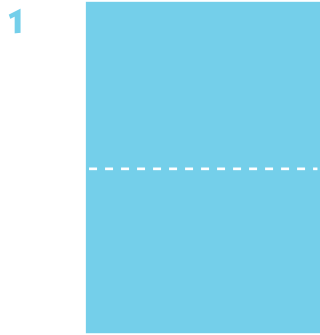
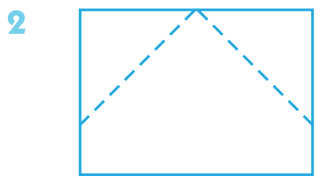


make your own bigger boat

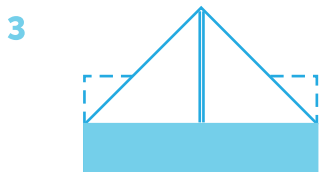


1 Take a sheet of A4 paper. Fold the upper half down on the dotted line.



2 Find the centre line by folding the left side on the right side and by unfolding.

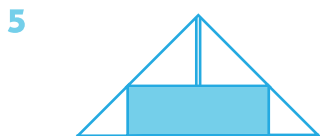
Fold down both upper triangles on the dotted line.



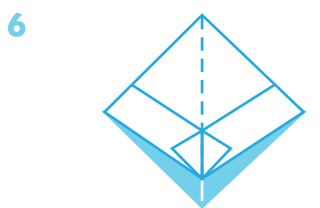
3 Fold up the bottom strip on the front and back of the paper.



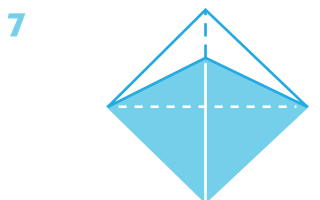
4 This is known as 'the hat'. Fold the corner triangle behind the strip.



5 You should now have a triangle shape.



6 Pull long sides out so the bottom corners come together to create a diamond shape; crease.



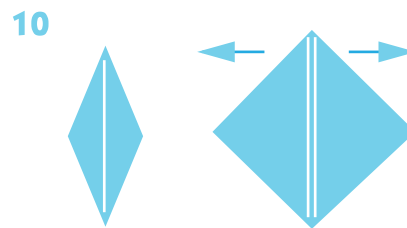
7 Fold up one bottom corner, making a triangle; crease.



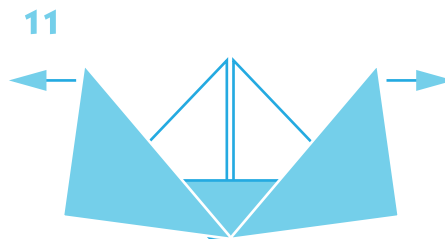
8 Turn paper over. Fold up remaining corner



9 Take a sheet of A4 paper. Fold the upper half down on the dotted line.



10 Pull the upper corners of the triangles in direction of the arrow



11 Pull the upper corners of the triangles in direction of the arrows as much as possible. Form the boat



12 The paper boat is finished

Stretch the boat both to the right and left, and then separate it slightly from underneath so it can float.
